We will be using this to write our own letters and fact files about animals and support our learning in Science.

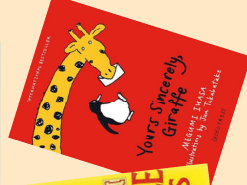
Finally we will be ending the year on a current affairs topic and will be writing about an event in the news at the time.

Magnificent Monarchs



In the Magnificent Monarchs project, we will be learning about English and British monarchs from AD 871 to the present day and consider how the power of the monarchy has changed over time.

We will also have 'The History Man' come to visit us to help us learn about the Tudor Period.



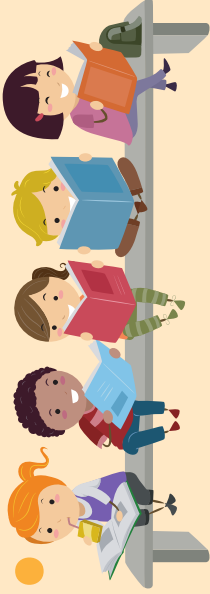

As part of our Magnificent Monarchs project we will be learning about significant places and royal residence in Geography.

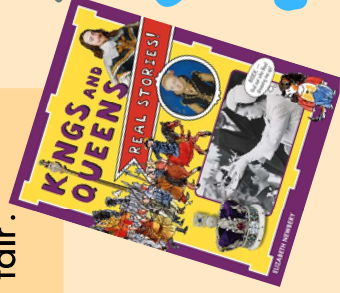


We will be doing two projects in science this term. The main project is 'Animal Survival'. This project teaches children about growth in animals by exploring the life cycles of some familiar animals.
