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I must begin by thanking those parents who were able to attend our annual Sports Day on Monday. The weather could not have been nicer; the competition was close and conducted with excellent sportsmanship; and your support helped to create a fantastic atmosphere. I cannot remember a Sports Day which had a larger representation from the parents – so thank you.

Our KS1 Sports saw Beacon accrue the highest number of points, closely followed by Orchard, then Tower, then Windmill. Our KS2 Sports ended with Tower having scored the most points, closely followed by Windmill, then Orchard, then Beacon. Congratulations to all the children for their enthusiastic participation and effort.

Sports Day was just the start of what has been a fabulous week. On Tuesday the children ran their mile, then KS1 tried to Beat the Goalie. In the afternoon KS2 had a World Cup Football Tournament, which was won by the Tower Tigers. Well done! Wednesday, the children had the chance to work with MK Dons; then on Thursday, following a special assembly from Parkrun, everyone wore themselves out doing a Metafit session; and Y5 and Y6 tried to score the highest number of points in archery. Today YR to Y4 are learning tennis skills. Today the children have come dressed representing a huge range of sports – most of which I have been able to guess correctly. Thank you for your donations for the fete. We would like to extend a huge thank you to MK Dons, Mr Evans from Parkrun, Miss Kelly, Marc from Wallingford Castle Archers, and Miss Stanley from Cheddington Tennis Club for their time and enthusiasm to inspire the children; and to Mrs van de Linde who has organised and co-ordinated this impressive range of activities.
